Cooperation with Joachim Franz's team and his AIDS awareness campaign brings international flair to the work of HOPE Cape Town

- Rev Fr Stefan Hippler receives prestigious Erich-Kaestner award in Dresden, Germany in November 2008. This award is accompanied by prize money of €10,000.00 for HOPE Cape Town.
- An elective student programme allows for internships of students of medicine with HOPE Cape Town and KID CRU. A medical student from Wuerzburg conducts her research for her doctoral thesis with the help of HOPE Cape Town.
- The 4th HOPE Gala in Dresden is a success and a tradition is created which links Hope Cape Town and Dresden via Saxonia Systems.
- In cooperation with InWent and the Missionsaerztliche Insitut Wuerzburg, the starting point is set for the development of an E-learning programme for medical students. The pilot is financed by the state of Bavaria. More cooperation with the Hochschule Niederrhein and the Technical University Munich in the fields of nutrition and sports are in the pipeline.
